# Regional Meetings of the Global Alliance of NGOs for Road Safety: *North America, Europe and Australasia*

The Regional Meeting will be the very first of all the Alliance events during the Fourth Global Ministerial Conference on Road Safety at the Palais de Congres in Marrakech, Morocco. The Alliance members onsite will come together as the region before we gather as the global network of NGOs at the Civil Society Call to Action and the NGO Symposium. These activities will help us set clear intentions to make the most of the opportunities presented by the Ministerial Conference and meaningfully participate in the events as well as engage the country delegations for the implementation of the Global Plan 2021-2030 during the Ministerial Conference week.

## **Objective**

The overall objective of the regional meeting is to offer the opportunity for the Alliance members of the North America, Europe and Australasia region<sup>1</sup> to exchange experiences, learnings, and inspirations derived from NGOs' engagement in Alliance-led initiatives and prepare ourselves to leverage the Ministerial Conference and effectively contribute to the implementation of the Global Plan 2021–2030. These discussions are held within the framework of the Alliance Strategy, guided by SDGs 3.6 and 11.2.

#### **Expected outcomes**

- Strengthened peer-to-peer learning and sense of unity of members in the region.
- Greater participation of NGOs in the Ministerial Conference and Alliance-led initiatives to stimulate and support in-country advocacy and engage governments in the region for the delivery of global road safety targets.
- Clearer intentions of the region to effectively contribute to the implementation of the Global Plan 2021–2030 in the follow up from the Ministerial Conference.
